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Water services affected during intersection work

Havre – Multiple water tie-ins at intersections 3rd, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Avenues continue as scheduled. During the work at the intersections, businesses should be prepared for temporary water shut-off. “There has been a lot of coordinating to ensure a quick reconnection of water services to those affected by the work throughout the next two weeks,” stated project manager, Sam Weyers. “Those businesses experiencing this inconvenience should note that water shut-off should last up to four hours. If you are without water for more than four hours, please contact the Nelcon Headquarters immediately.”

For the west end, the placement of concrete has been postponed until May 19th. Concrete Placing Company (CPC) will begin paving the middle lanes of traffic. CPC and Nelcon will be working with businesses affected by the traffic shifts to ensure adequate business access.

In light of the highly anticipated completion date of the US-2 construction project, the *Havre Daily News* has started a count down to completion with a cash prize for the closest guess for the expected date.
